

Racing HF Kickwax

DESIGNED FOR WORLD CUP RACING -- HIGH PERFORMANCE FOR EVERYONE



Blue HF Kick -1..-20°C / 30..-4°F

All snow except new snow. A wax kit must!
Functions excellently across its entire range for grip and glide. A soft and distinct grip. Contains high amounts of a new fluoro. Apply 4-6 layers generously. Try HF Red +1/-3 when not enough grip in fine or crystal snow. Can be effective with certain new snow in special mountain conditions.



Violet HF Kick -2..15°C / 28..5°F

For new and fine structured snow. High humidity. Used often as a cover wax for a softer kickwax or klister when tracks have blown snow or light fresh snow. Choose HF Violet kickwax over HF Blue when grip seems to be equal because HF Violet glides better. Good with fresh man-made snow.



Red HF Kick +1..-3°C / 34..27°F

All snow types. Matches the trickiest temperature zone to select kickwax. Has a distinct and soft grip. Contains high amounts of a new fluoro. Apply 4-6 layers generously. Can work well below -3C when snow is fine grained and "slippery", or when snow is granular to very granular (e.g. -10C).



Yellow HF Kick +5..-1°C / 41..30°F

For all snow conditions. A "must try" before using klister. Very resistant to icing and clumping. Regularly used to cover klister. Excellent gliding performance! Cover with HF Violet kickwax when fresh cold snow (from an inversion) is falling. Applied most easily by 'hot' methods.

Yellow HF Klister +3..+20°C / 37..68°F

Fluoro-based klister. All snow conditions even with glazed tracks. Very dirt resistant. Glide properties are superb while having a tremendous grip. Racing teams choice!



Violet HF Klister +2..-2°C / 36..28°F

Fluoro-based klister. For coarse snow and artificial snow and glazed tracks. When sopping wet or snow lacks enough structure for kickwax. Cover with HF Violet kickwax or HF Red kickwax if new snow is falling, wind-blown or mixed into the track.

SPECIAL MIXES:

- Canmore Special: 2 layers of HF Blue covered by 2 layers of HF Violet
- Cold Abrasive Granular: HF Red feathered thick over Ski*go Violet klister binder (thin)
- Structured Snow Warm & Wet: HF Yellow Klister covered by HF Yellow kickwax
- Mixed Granular: 2 layers HF Red covered by 2 layers HF Blue
- Very Aged Cold: HF Blue & HF Red mixed together by cork (3:1 ratio)

NOTES:

- Always sandpaper your kick zone
- Use Base kickwax in abrasive conditions
- Polished kickwax gives better glide
- Polished kickwax gives better grip
- Test chosen wax on actual race track
